

CORRIGENDUM NOTICE

REF -: Expression of Interest (EOI) from reputed and experienced Vendors to install, operationalise and maintain a CCTV based City Surveillance System and Intelligent Traffic monitoring System for the city of Bhubaneswar. Advertisement published in Samaj dt.20.07.2013, Sambad dt.20.07.2013, Times of India dt.20.07.2013, Economic Times dt.20.07.2013.

1. Clause 3 of section 6.2.1 , p 22 in the EOI document under the heading Technical shall be deleted.
2. Clause 7 of section 6.2.1 , P 23 in the EOI document under the heading “Technical” should read as follows.
“Those that have not executed any city surveillance projects but have executed projects employing at least 100 IP based cameras over large campuses with mostly outdoor camera installations will also be eligible to apply. Proof of such outdoor deployment with the drawings of locations and the letter from the user certifying such deployment must be provided.
Projects executed only inside India will be considered for the purpose.”
3. Clause 7.8, P 29 should read as follows.
“**EMD:** All EOIs will have to be submitted latest by 23 August 2013 up to 1.00 PM in this office and the same shall be publicly opened on the same day at 3:30 PM. **The Project Developers / bidders will have to submit an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs 10, 00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs only) along with the EOI which shall be refunded to all the unsuccessful Project Developers/bidders immediately after the issue of RFPs.** All EOIs have to be submitted along with document fee and EMD failing which the EOI shall not be accepted / *considered*. **EMDs can be paid by bank draft issued from any Nationalized bank drawn in favour of “The Odisha State Police Housing and Welfare Corporation Ltd”**”

payable at Bhubaneswar. Bidders can also pledge Fixed Deposit Receipts of only Nationalized bank for the same amount in favour of “The Odisha State Police Housing and Welfare Corporation Ltd” payable at Bhubaneswar.

The CMD, OSPHWC reserves the right to reject one or all the EOIs without assigning any reasons thereof.

4. Provisional Balance sheet and P/L statement for the Financial Year 2012-13 certified by a practising Chartered Accountant shall be considered in case non availability of audited balance sheet for the same year. In such case the audited Balance sheet and P/L statement of the parties successful in the EOI stage will have to be submitted along with the response to the RFP.
5. Bids can be submitted in 4th Floor, office of the Headquarters of OSPHWC, Bhubaneswar in person/ by courier/post up to 1.00 P.M. of 23.08. 2013. Bids will be opened at 3.30 P.M. on the same day in the Training hall located on the 4th. Floor of the OSPHWC Corporate Office, Bhubaneswar. Bids submitted after the closing time specified above will not be considered under any circumstances.

8. All the queries technical in nature shall be clarified in the RFP (Request for Proposal) which will be circulated only to those are successful in the EOI stage.
