Sub: Payment of Tender Premium on Works executed through OSPH&WC.

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to the subject above and say that a reference has been made by the CMD of OSPH&WC in his Letter No 42/CON/OPHWC dated 31.01.2017 to this department seeking intervention on the issue regarding Payment of Tender Premium on Works due to conflicting stand as reported in the letter of IG of Police (Modernization) vide No 3942 dated 30.01.2017 to the address of CMD, OSPH&WC. In this connection the following practice shall be enforced to tide over the disputes relating to payment of Tender Premium to the corporation.

The Working Procedure relating to Premium of Tender Value has been well defined in Paragraph 3 of Works Department Resolution No 9133 dated 06.09.2012 to regulate the claims between the user and executing agency inter-se. This has been reinforced in Paragraph B (4) of this department guidelines issued to all concerned vide Letter No 28847 dated 06.08.2013. Further it is also pertinent to mention here that the responsibility of user organization as well as the corporation has been clearly defined in the MOU, signed between this department with the Corporation to facilitate smooth implementation of projects and delivery of service. There is least scope of any discretion on the part of either party to act contrary to the above settled principles thereto.

You are therefore requested to look into the matter for settlement of the legitimate dues of the corporation on account of Tender Premium in accordance with regulatory working procedure to dissipate any controversy and settlement of audit objections on this account.
